



Landfill Bans And Recycling Options

The Integrated Solid Waste Management Act was created by Legislative Bill 1257 in 1992. This Act identified the timeline for banning specific materials from land disposal. The legislative bans were designed to eliminate problematic materials from the waste stream and extend the life of landfills. Materials banned from land disposal are listed with their definition and land disposal ban date.

Lead-acid batteries – electrical storage batteries with cells that contain lead electrodes and an acidic electrolyte, such as those commonly used in motor vehicles. Banned September 1, 1994.

Waste Oil – any oil that has been refined from crude oil, used, and as a result of such use, is contaminated by physical or chemical impurities. Banned September 1, 1994.

Yard waste – grass and leaves. Yard waste is banned from land disposal from April 1 to November 30 of each year. Banned September 1, 1994.

Discarded household appliances – clothes washers and dryers, water heaters, heat pumps, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, trash compactors, dishwashers, conventional ovens, ranges, stoves and wood stoves. Banned September 1, 1995.

Waste tires (in any form) – a tire that is no longer suitable for its original intended purpose because of wear, damage or defect. Banned September 1, 1998.

Unregulated hazardous waste – a hazardous waste containing free liquids, or hazardous waste in solid form in a container greater in size or volume than 5 gallons or in a quantity greater in weight than 19.5 kilograms (43 pounds), which are generated by a conditionally exempt small quantity generator. This does not include household hazardous waste. Banned September 1, 1996.

Recycling Options For Banned Items

Recycling options exist for those materials banned from land disposal. The *Nebraska Recycling Programs* section of this directory identifies recycling facilities under the county they are located. Many business sites accept waste oil, lead-acid batteries and waste tires. If no site is listed for your area, contact local service stations and garages.

Some household appliance and yard waste disposal sites are listed. Contact local municipalities, landfills or transfer stations if a household appliance or yard waste site is not listed for your area. Generally, municipalities have yard waste compost sites available for public use. You can also compost waste you have generated at your residence. There are several program alternatives for unregulated hazardous waste. Local programs and resources that may include a hazardous waste collection day in your area are private businesses involved in the collection of hazardous waste, local health departments and University extension services. Contact your local officials for available alternatives in your area.

Nebraska Pesticide Container Recycling Program

Recycling clean agricultural pesticide containers is a way that you can help protect Nebraska's environment. Clean, rinsed, white and yellow plastic agricultural pesticide containers of 2.5 gallons or smaller can be brought to the collection sites listed below. The following guidelines should be followed to properly prepare the containers:

- Containers must be pressure rinsed or triple rinsed. Add the rinse water directly to the spray tank.
- Containers should be clean inside and out – stained containers are accepted but they must be clean.
- Any dried pesticide residue on the container or remaining pesticide liquid is not acceptable.
- Slip-cover plastic labels and lids should be removed from the container.

Each container is inspected upon delivery at the collection site before acceptance. **Check with the collection site contacts, or your local UNL Extension Educator, for specific dates and times of collections. Information can also be obtained from the website at pested.unl.edu/pestrecy.htm**

Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Options

If your household is like many Nebraska households, you have a variety of products in your bathroom, kitchen, workshop, and garage. Many of these products such as paint, paint thinners, pesticides, fertilizers, gasoline, windshield wiper fluid, antifreeze, motor oil, brake fluid, adhesives, batteries, furniture, polish, drain openers, oven cleaners, metal polishes, and varnishes are hazardous. These products are hazardous because they contain chemicals that are corrosive, explosive, flammable or toxic.

When hazardous household products are no longer usable or wanted, they become household hazardous wastes. Household hazardous waste poses a threat to sanitation workers and the environment if disposed of improperly.

Before purchasing a hazardous product look for a non-hazardous or less hazardous product to perform each job. Always try to buy just enough of a product to do the job. Be sure to read product labels and follow directions carefully. Always keep leftover products in the original container and if possible share the unused products with neighbors or friends. Completely use all contents prior to disposing of empty containers.

Household hazardous waste collection programs may be available in your community. Contact your local recycling center or extension office for possible collections in your area. There are some organizations in the state that hold regular collection events for household hazardous waste. The following is a list and name of a contact person for these collection programs:

Waste Planning and Aid Programs

Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Grants Program:

The Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Grants Program awards funding to public and private entities for a variety of integrated waste management programs and projects. In addition, the program awards grants and loans to public and private entities for projects directly related to the management of scrap tires in the state. Priority funding consideration is given to applications that contribute to the development of markets for recycled materials. See table on page 25 for related information.

Illegal Dumpsite Cleanup Program: Established in 1997, this is a cleanup program that provides funding assistance to political subdivisions for the cleanup of solid waste disposed of along public roadways or ditches. Funding for this program is up to five percent of the total revenue from the disposal fee collected in the preceding fiscal year. Through this program, items such as household waste, white goods, construction and demolition waste, and furniture, are removed from the illegal site and disposed in a permitted facility or recycled.

Landfill Disposal Fee Rebate Program: The Landfill Disposal Fee Rebate Program was created as an incentive to political subdivisions to support and encourage the purchasing of products, materials, or supplies that are manufactured or produced from recycled material. Funding for the program is drawn from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund. Under the program, any municipality or county may apply for a rebate if they have a written purchasing policy in effect requiring a preference for purchasing

products, materials or supplies which are manufactured or produced from recycled material.

If the policy is approved by NDEQ, the applicant may receive a 10-cent rebate from the \$1.25 per ton disposal fee. Rebates are issued quarterly. Since its inception in 1995, seven communities have participated in the program.

Green Buildings are homes built with the assurance that they have been built to exacting energy and environmental standards established by the Nebraska's Energy Office and constructed by a certified builder. The homes earn a five-star energy rating, are built by a certified contractor and have features that make them healthier and more comfortable while reducing energy use and their impact on the environment. New owners of these homes will save about \$90 a month compared to traditionally built homes.

Glossary

Glossary

Commercial Waste - Waste material that originates in wholesale, retail or service sectors.

Compactor - Any power-driven mechanical equipment designed to compress waste materials, usually attached to an enclosed container.

Compost - A humus-like material resulting from the biological decomposition of organic materials.

Composting - The controlled aerobic, thermophilic, microbial degradation of solid organic materials such as raw or treated sewage sludge, animal manure, paunch manure, plant or food residue, or their mixtures, to stabilized, humus-like material.

Construction and Demolition Waste (C&D) – Waste which results from land clearing, the demolition of buildings, roads or other structures, including, but not limited to, beneficial fill materials, wood (including painted and treated wood), land clearing debris other than yard waste, wall coverings (including wall paper, paneling and tile), drywall, plaster, non-asbestos insulation, roofing shingles and other roof coverings, plumbing fixtures, glass, plastic, carpeting, electrical wiring, pipe and metals. Such waste shall also include the above listed types of waste that result from construction projects.

Curbside Collection – A method of collecting recyclable material at individual homes or places of business by municipal or private parties for transfer to a designated collection site or recycling facility.

Drop-Off Center – A designated collection site where individuals can deliver recyclable materials.

Hazardous Waste – Any solid, liquid, or contained gaseous material that is no longer of use which, if improperly stored, transported or disposed of, can cause injury or death to humans, or damage or pollute land, air or water.

Household Appliances – See White Goods

Household Hazardous Waste – Hazardous waste that is generated from consumer products used in the home such as cleaning supplies, batteries, automotive products, pesticides, paints, and photography chemicals.

Lead-acid Batteries – Electrical storage batteries with cells containing electrodes and an acidic electrolyte, such as those commonly used in motor vehicles.

Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) – Any facility at which solid waste is sorted and/or processed for the purpose of resource recovery.

Metals

Aluminum – A light metal made from bauxite ore that can be easily bent or crushed.

Bi-metal Can – A can with parts made of different metals, usually steel, tin or aluminum.

Ferrous Metals – Magnetic metals which are predominantly composed of iron. Included are scrap iron and steel items, bi-metal cans and stainless steel scrap.

Non-ferrous Metals – Metals that contain no iron, such as aluminum, copper, brass and bronze.

Steel – Any of the various hard, strong, durable malleable alloys of iron and carbon, often with other constituents such as copper and nickel.

Tin Can – Essentially a steel can with a thin coating of tin, used for food packaging.

Mixed Recyclables – Items that are separated from household or commercial trash for recycling, but are not separated from each other until a later time and at a different location.

Municipal Solid Waste – Household waste and/or the combination of household waste with industrial or commercial solid wastes.

Paper – A thin sheet material made of cellulose pulp, derived mainly from wood, rags and certain grasses.

Cardboard – See Corrugated Materials

Corrugated Materials (commonly referred as cardboard)– Paper products made from stiff pasteboard formed into fluted ridges and grooves, including kraft paper with ruffled inner liners. This does not include paperboard or boxboard such as cereal boxes.

High Grade Paper - Relatively valuable types of paper such as computer printout and white ledger.

Kraft Paper - A comparatively coarse paper particularly noted for its strength and made primarily from wood pulp. Used in grocery bags and corrugated boxes.

Mixed Paper - Waste paper of various kinds and qualities usually collected from stores, offices, and schools.

Newsprint – Inexpensive paper made from wood pulp or recycled paper, used chiefly for newspaper.

Office Paper – White bond, colored ledger, envelopes without windows and computer paper.

Paperboard – Heavier in weight, thicker, and more rigid than paper. Some examples are: container board, boxboard, and special types of building board.

Plastic – Any of various complex organic compounds produced by polymerization. They can be molded, extruded or cast into various shapes and films or drawn into filaments used as textile fibers. The following codes identify the appropriate resin type used to produce the structure of the container.

#1 (PET) – Polyethylene Terephthalate. Plastics having clarity, strength, toughness, barrier to gas and moisture, resistance to heat. Commonly used in soft drink bottles, water, sports drinks, and beer.

#2 (HDPE) – High density polyethylene. Plastic with good barrier properties and stiffness and is well suited to packaging products with a short shelf life such as milk. HDPE has good chemical resistance and is used for packaging many household and industrial chemicals.

#3 (V) – Polyvinyl chloride (PVC). Plastic that has versatility, clarity, ease of bending, strength, toughness, resistance to grease, oil and chemicals. Commonly used in clear food and non-food packaging, construction products such as pipes, fittings and window frames.

#4 (LDPE) – Low density polyethylene. Plastic used predominately in film applications due to its toughness, flexibility and relative transparency. Dry cleaning bags, bread bags, and squeezable bottles, e.g. honey, mustard are examples of #4 plastics.

#5 (PP) – Polypropylene. Plastic that has good chemical resistance, is strong, and has a high melting point making it good for hot-fill liquids. Uses include items catsup bottles, yogurt containers, margarine tubs and medicine bottles.

#6 (PS) – Polystyrene. Plastic that can be rigid or foamed. Uses include compact disc jackets, food service applications and egg cartons

#7 and/or other – Denotes all plastics not included in the other six categories, such as multi-resin containers. Uses include three and five gallon reusable water bottles, some citrus juice and catsup bottles.

Postconsumer Material – Materials generated from residential and commercial wasters, excluding recycling of material from industrial processes that has not reached the consumer, such as broken glass in the manufacturing process.

Preconsumer Material – Discarded materials from industrial and manufacturing processes that have been recovered or diverted from the solid waste stream.

Recycling – Separating, collecting, processing, marketing, and ultimately using a material that would have been thrown away.

Reuse – The use of a product more than once in its same form for the same purpose or for different purposes.

Scrap Tire – A tire that is no longer suitable for its original intended purpose because of wear, damage or defect.

Source Reduction – Any action that prevents waste from occurring in the first place, such as the purchase or production of items in just the quantity needed, and items that use less material, have a longer life or can be reused.

Textiles – Used clothing and scraps of clean cloth.

Toxic – Ability of a substance to produce harmful or lethal effects on humans and/or the environment.

Waste Oil – Any oil that has been refined from crude oil, used, and as a result of such use, is contaminated by physical or chemical impurities.

White Goods – Clothes washers and dryers, water heaters, heat pumps, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, trash compactors, dishwashers, conventional ovens, ranges, stoves and wood stoves.

Waste Tire – See Scrap Tire

Yard Waste – Grass and leaves. For the purposes of composting, yard waste shall mean grass and leaves in combination with chipped trees and branches and other organic material collected as the result of the care of ornamental plants, lawns, shrubbery, vines, and gardens.
