Graduate Outcomes

The Workforce Investment Act provided the impetus for the Graduate Outcomes project to develop a system of consumer information. It is a collaborative effort among Nebraska Workforce Development – Department of Labor, the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education, all six of Nebraska's Community Colleges, all three State Colleges and the University of Nebraska – Kearney.

Who uses graduate outcomes information?

Prospective students planning their education need information to help select a college and major. Colleges and regulatory commissions need the information to improve educational programs in the state. Workforce Investment Boards, economic developers, and policy makers need information on labor supply to help meet the needs of businesses in Nebraska.

Questions answered by the project include:


Results from the Graduate Outcomes project give a clearer picture of recent graduates' earnings, industry employment, and work location.

- Which majors produce graduates most likely to be employed in Nebraska?
- Which majors produce graduates with the highest wages?
- What industries employ recent graduates?
- In which counties are graduates employed?
- What are the demographic characteristics of graduates?

The Appendix of this publication contains detailed spreadsheets for participating institutions that include the percent of graduates working in Nebraska plus earnings by field of study and degree. It also includes industry employment by major and degree along with earnings information.



Graduate Demographics Southeast Community College



- The estimated average annual earnings for all wage and salary workers in the region served by Southeast Community College were \$32,819 according to the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages 2007 first quarter average multiplied by four. This is the same methodology used to produce graduate estimates.

- The 34 Black, non-Hispanic graduates constituted 2% of Southeast Community College's graduates. According to the 2000 Census, non-Hispanic Black or African American alone race made up 2% of the region served by Southeast Community College.

- For people age 16 and older, men in this area had average annual earnings of \$26,538 while women earned an average of \$14,030, according to the 2000 Census.

- 8% of the population age 25 and older in the Southeast Community College service area had an Associate Degree according to the 2000 Census; 7% of the state population had an Associate Degree.

Graduate Industry Employment Southeast Community College



- Of the 1,768 Southeast Community College 2005-2006 graduates, 1,344 (76%) were employed in the state in the first quarter of 2007.
- Nine different fields of study had 90% or more of the graduates employed in Nebraska.
- Graduates were employed in 60 of Nebraska's 93 counties, with the highest number of graduates in Lancaster County.
- Fire Protection and Safety Technology/Technician graduates earned the highest estimated annual earnings of \$42,672; 86% of the 42 graduates were employed in the state.
- Graduates from 10 fields of study had average estimated annual earnings higher than \$30,000.
- Health Care employed 329 graduates, more than any other industry in Nebraska, with average annual earnings of \$28,156.



This is important because Health Care Practitioners and Technology occupations are projected to have 2,776 annual openings between 2006 and 2016 with 1,722 of those openings due to growth according to Nebraska Workforce Development's Occupational Projections.
- Overall, 75% of community college graduates were working in the state; 84% of Health Care graduates were employed in Nebraska. Registered Nursing graduates were even more likely (90%) to be employed in the state.
- Annual earnings for Health Care graduates compare favorably with all graduates' wages; Registered Nursing graduates had estimated earnings over \$38,670 per year, all Health Care fields of study graduates had median estimated earnings of \$27,163 and \$22,645 for all graduates.








- When individuals are employed by businesses with 100 or more employees, over 97% offered their employees health insurance, according to the 2006 Nebraska Employee Benefits Survey.
- Graduates from four of the six Community Colleges were slightly more likely to be employed in private industry compared to all employment. Graduates from Mid-Plains Community College and Western Nebraska Community College had higher percentages of graduates working in Public Education and Health Care.
- Southeast Community College graduates were employed in State Government at the highest percentage (4%) of all Nebraska Community Colleges.



Graduate Industry Employment Northeast Community College



- In the first quarter of 2007, 529 (73%) of the 724 2005-2006 Northeast Community College graduates were employed in Nebraska.
- Twenty-two different fields of study had 90% or more of the graduates employed in the state.
- At least one graduate was employed in 39 of Nebraska's 93 counties and most graduates were employed in the northeast corner of the state.
- Lineworker graduates had the highest annual estimated earnings of \$48,597; 74% of the 34 graduates were employed in the state.
- Four fields of study had graduates with estimated average annual earnings higher than \$30,000.
- Health Care employed 134 graduates, more than any other industry, with estimated average annual earnings of \$26,161.










- Graduates from four of the six Community Colleges were slightly more likely to be employed in private industry compared to all employment. Graduates from Mid-Plains Community College and Western Nebraska Community College had higher percentages of graduates working in Public Education and Health Care.



- For people age 16 and older, men in this area had average annual earnings of \$32,436 while women earned an average of \$16,696, according to the 2000 Census.

- 7% of the population age 25 and older in the Metropolitan Community College service area had an Associate Degree according to the 2000 Census. This is the same percentage as for the state as a whole.


- There were 1,020 2005 – 2006 Metropolitan Community College graduates. In the first quarter of 2007 there were 770 (75%) employed in Nebraska.

 - Graduates were employed in 16 of Nebraska's 93 counties, with the highest number of graduates employed in Douglas County.
 - Registered Nursing graduates had the highest estimated annual earnings of \$41,943; 76% of the 37 graduates were employed in Nebraska.
 - Seven fields of study had graduates with estimated average annual earnings higher than \$35,000.
 - Health Care employed 136 graduates, more than any other industry, with estimated average annual earnings of \$26,161.




















































Facts about the data:

Graduates don't necessarily have a job in their chosen career field immediately after graduation. Data matches are postponed to give graduates time to be working in a career field. For individuals graduating in May or June of one year, the database is queried first quarter of the following year.

Not all graduates can be found. If they are not found it doesn't mean they are "unemployed" it means that they could not be located in the administrative database. Individuals who are self employed, or work in occupations not covered by Unemployment Insurance, or are enrolled in postsecondary education and aren't working, or work in another state, are unlikely to be found in the database. The institution's proximity to Nebraska borders might make some students less likely to be located.

It is not possible to tell if graduates are employed in occupations related to their education. Only the employing industry is known. A Registered Nursing graduate, working in the health care industry, might be employed as a hospital administrator or a hospital janitor.

When there are small numbers of students in a program/course, a few unusual results can easily affect the percentages. To protect individual confidentiality, programs with fewer than four graduates working in the state are not published.

The annual earnings estimate is based on a snapshot of wages. Wages for first quarter are multiplied by four to obtain the earnings estimate. It does not reveal what happens to graduates' earnings before or after they complete their education or training.

Earnings may be for full- or part-time work. Earnings reported in the database include wages, salaries, bonuses, commissions and other income designated as earnings under Nebraska Unemployment Insurance laws. Wages tend to vary across regions. The wage information listed relates to all individuals found working in Nebraska and may be influenced by strong regional variations.
